On Friday, October 23, we were alerted to a video posted by Andre Abram (IG Name: @lilajdre), showing the front sidewalk of our business and portions of our signage. In the video, a Scottsdale resident who lives above our gallery, is recorded making heinous, racist, abhorrent and wholly unacceptable remarks to Mr. Abram.

We are in no way, shape or form affiliated with the man who made these racist remarks. He lives in the condo above the gallery and we condemn his actions to the fullest extent possible.

River Trading Post has been in Scottsdale since 2001 and we take pride in accepting and embracing all human beings regardless of race, gender, creed, sexual identity etc. We will continue to embrace everyone and honor the Native artists whom we proudly represent.

We have receive much public outcry about this video, as many have assumed the man on the racist tirade was affiliated with our business. He is not now, nor never has been.

We believe the City of Scottsdale will pursue this case with criminal charges, and we will assist in their investigation if asked.
